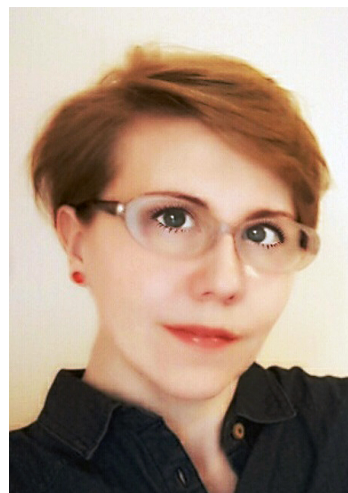


Letter from the Editor
